Staggered breaks and lunch times remain in place to reduce the numbers in our playground.

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Our Recovery Priorities

Already we are working on aspects of this years Recovery Improvement Priorities.

Improvement Priority 1 - Continuity of Learning As the children are now receiving all aspects of the curriculum we are looking at revising our content and making it relevant and progressive for the children in Woodside. This will be an ongoing and major focus for us this year.

All staff have undertaken training on a new approach to teaching spelling which has a greater focus on phonics and spelling strategies. This means we will not be having a Friday spelling test but rather daily practice with lots of pupil led activities. Spelling homework will reinforce content from the previous week. More information on this new approach will follow soon.

Our support staff have all been trained on 'Catch Up Literacy' and this will be rolled out to targeted pupils.

Improvement Priority 2 - Promote the positive health and wellbeing of children, parents/carers and staff - Our 'Emotion Works' programme is back in place in all classes. Evelyn McGonagle our Youth, Family and Community Learning Officer is with us every Wednesday and Thursday. She is already monitoring the attendance and late coming of some pupils and has supported a few Primary 1 families starting school



My job is to work with the staff team and support Parents/Carers and families in a range of ways. This could include: phone calls, informal sessions on helping children's literacy, building confidence/positive relationships with children, and practical tips on helping your child succeed. (These may be offered online due to Covid restrictions). All sessions will be relaxed, provide suggestions on the topics but give Parents/Carers the important time to meet others, share experiences and ideas.

Already I have worked with a few of our new Primary 1 families and it has been fantastic to see their settled start to school. I am also monitoring the attendance of a few pupils and I may be in touch with you on ways to support you in ensuring your child comes to school everyday.

Building positive and genuine relationships with Parents/Carers and families is at the heart of what I do. I look forward to getting to know you and working together to ensure our children are happy, confident and achieve.



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Buddy Playtime

There was HUGE excitement when we were able to start up our buddy programme again. Our Big Primary 6 Buddies had the chance to meet and play with their Wee Primary 1 Buddies out in the




playground. Obviously, we kept this as safe as possible and the playtimes were in class groups over a period of days. It was so lovely to see our P7 Buddies finally meeting their Primary 2 Buddies in person; an experience we can hopefully build on this session.

Google Classroom and Homework

Throughout lockdown we used 'Google Classroom' as a way of delivering online learning and remaining in contact with all our

like their pencil case or a notebook in their bag.



Homework will start week beginning 13th September. Our initial focus will be on reading and numeracy. Your child may have a reading book in their bag and be given pages to read at home with a parent. Each week there will also be a numeracy task to complete and this will be posted on the Google Classroom.

Not all homework can be completed online and in infant classes, a different approach will be necessary. More information about this will follow soon.

As teachers are in front of the class everyday we are unable to supply daily class work on the Google Classroom. Isolation grids will be popped on the Google Classroom from the 13th September for any child at home who is isolating as they await their PCR test results. If your child is absent due to a positive result, there is no expectation that they need to complete work at home as we want them to focus on getting better again.

Gym Shoes

We have received a number of calls regarding Gym shoes. As we can now participate in PE lessons indoors, I kindly ask that all children have a comfortable and safe pair of shoes which they can leave in school. The children will also wear these indoors throughout the school day. This helps keep our building clean and dry especially as we approach the winter months. I appreciate this is an extra cost for families so please do not feel the need to run out and purchase these straight away.
