Improvement Planning

This year our improvement priorities were to focus on the following areas:-

- Improve attainment in writing especially in P 5 7
- Improve attainment in numeracy specifically with targeted pupils
- Further engage parents by developing curricular knowledge of literacy and numeracy to enable them to support their children

So far we have created a 'Parental Engagement Calendar' to make sure that we are offering a range of opportunities for parental involvement across the school year. It was great to see so many of you at our last couple of workshops. If you haven't yet attended one of our workshops, look out for the February date.

All the teaching staff spent time reflecting on teaching and learning in writing, at the INSET day on Monday 19th November. We will be trying out some different approaches and organisation for writing in our classes. As we have Ms Lennox and Mrs Ferguson out of class they are working in partnership with all teachers to support the teaching of writing. We have been using our monitoring and tracking data for Literacy and Numeracy to ensure that our Support Staff are targeting some children with the '5 minute box' resource.

Science Spot

Second Level Science

Primary 5-7 have been creating scaled diagrams of the solar system investigating the distance from the sun and the size of the planets. They have also been researching the life of astronauts including their life and work in space and presenting this in a Google Slide presentation.

First Level Science

Primary 2-4 have been learning about gravity and the effects it has on us on Earth. They designed mini parachutes to demonstrate this and discussed how we could explore this investigation further by changing size and materials used. They have also been looking at some topical science including deforestation and the effects it has on humans, animals, plants and our planet.

Early Level Science

Primary One have been exploring why the number of daylight hours changes over the year and discussing the seasons. They have been participating in some fun STEM challenges and exploring some topical science including deforestation.

Numeracy and Maths

Many classes are participating in a 'Sumdog' competition this week and we are looking forward to seeing where our school is ranked in South Lanarkshire by the end of the week. Please remember to encourage your child to In Primary 1, in maths we have been learning number stories 4 and 5. In Primary 2, in maths we have been learning about 2D shapes and 3D objects and counting and adding up to 20. In P1, we have been learning new sounds like g, d, a and s and our reading book has been 'What a bad dog!'. In P2 we have been reading non-fiction.

In P6 we have been learning about different ways to add and subtract. We are enjoying revising our times tables. However, it's not in the usual way...we have been singing our tables – our Maths 'rocks' this year! In writing we have been learning all the different types and features of poems. In topic we have been learning lots about the Victorians and are reading a Victorian book called 'Street Child.' While we read, we focus on a range of different strategies including comparing, visualising and summarising. In PE we have been learning netball and all the different types of passes.
