

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Our School Recovery Plan

Every session we evaluate our current position and plan our improvement strategies for the year ahead.

- ⇒ Improvement Priority 1 Continuity of Learning
- ⇒ Improvement Priority 2 Promote the positive health and wellbeing of children, parents/carers and staff
- ⇒ Improvement Priority 3 Planning for Equity

For more detailed information, copies of both our 'Recovery Plan 2021-22' and our 'Standards and Quality Report' will be added on our website. We will keep you updated regarding the progress of our work throughout the session.

Mrs McKellar is leading our Equity Priorities. Each year the school is allocated money to be used to close our school equity gap. This year we have been allocated £126,808.

5% of this budget, £6340.40 is called our Participatory Budget and is to be used in consultation with our children and parents. This means we are looking for your input and help.

Covid update and changes

As a result of the First Minister's announcement on Tuesday 3rd August, Covid mitigation arrangements on the whole will continue as they were before the summer holidays. These will be reviewed after the next Scottish Government update in 5 weeks.

As of Monday, our Primary 1 children will start at 8.45am and finish at 2.45pm. This will mean our gates will be busier. Please allow space for our wee people to come in and be able to see their parents at the end of the day. Please can I ask that face masks are worn for drop offs and pick ups, thank you.

We are hoping to use some of the space in the top car park for parents collecting children at the Merc Garage at the end of the day. Can I kindly ask that you don't stand on the Merc Garage property or allow the children to play on their wall. Thank you.

Our initial priority has been settling the children back into school. As of next week we will no longer have 'class bubbles' in the playground. There have been many benefits to this arrangement as it has made playground management better. For this reason we are going to introduce year group areas as I know the children are desperate to see their friends at the same stage.



Children travelling on the school bus no longer need to wear their face mask. We are currently looking at our bus numbers and will continue to allocate every child their own seat. This system made our bus management safer for all.

I will keep you updated with any other changes and Scottish Government guidelines.

Please be vigilant for symptoms of COVID-19. If your child develops any symptoms of COVID-19 **they must not attend school.** They should stay at home, self-isolate and get tested for COVID-19. Please make sure you contact the school office to inform them of your child's absence and update us on the results of any PCR tests.
