Self Isolating One Off Payment		
New Cases from 16 th August 2021		
This will be made to parents/carers towards the cost of lunch for pupils who are eligible for free school meals but can't attend school because they are self-isolating as part of the Test and Protect Scheme. The child will have tested positive for COVID-19 or been identified by NHS Test and Protect as a close contact. This does not cover short periods of isolation, where pupils are waiting for a test result.	One off payment of £25.00. There is no need to apply, payment is made direct into bank account.
