Dear Parents and Carers.

Welcome to our first newsletter of 2022!

I hope you all managed to have a safe festive break and enjoyed the special time with your children and families.

It has been great to see our children back in school all excited to pass on their Christmas stories. I must stress the importance of calling the school office if your child is absent. Current guidelines mean we have to record the reason for absences under different codes, especially if it is COVID-19 related. We need ask parents who are reporting a pupil absence to confirm the following information:

- Pupils name and class
- The reason for their absence
- If their absence is Covid-19 related please also confirm
- Who has been for a PCR test
- Who in the family is COVID positive, so we know whether a pupil is isolating due to a positive test or due to being a close contact
- The last date of their isolation/when they are due back in school

Your support with this is appreciated and helps to reduce the number of return calls we need to make to clarify this information.

We are coming back to a couple of staff changes. Mrs Faloon, our DHT for Primary 1-3 children is away to St Anthony's Primary in Rutherglen as Acting Head Teacher. This was a very last minute change and whilst she is away Mrs Eileen McKellar will be the Acting DHT taking over her position. Mrs McKellar knows the children very well and has liaised very closely with Mrs Faloon.
