Dear Parents and Carers,

School almost feels a bit more normal now with everyone starting and finishing at the same time. With the introduction of this positive step forward we also made a few changes to our break times.

Breaks are now:- P4-7 10.30am-10.45am and P1-3 10.45am - 11am.

Lunchtimes are :- P4-7 12noon - 12.45pm and P1-3 12.45pm-1.30pm

Our children are now playing in their year group zones and we have organised our lunches to allow all the children, (packed lunch and school dinners) to sit together beside their year group friends in the dining hall.



Our new lunchtime organisation has enabled us

to accommodate more classes using the gym hall for PE. Primary 5,6 and 7 will have PE outside once a week, and Primary 1 – Primary 4 are now indoors. This means they can wear their uniform to school everyday. Please make sure your child has their gym kit and a change of gym shoes in school. Lots of positive steps forward! At present there has been no more updates from the Scottish Government regarding schools. I will keep you posted.

The roads outside of school are extremely busy at 3pm, this is the only disadvantage to us all finishing at the same time! I must stress the importance of keeping all our children and families safe. Please think carefully about where you park at this time as we have had some complaints of dangerous driving outside the school.
