Improvement Planning

In January, the class blogs were made available on our website and we had a Parents as Partners' workshop in February. We always welcome ideas on how to vary the ways and in which we can work together with you as parents and carers.



Staff have developed child-friendly assessment grids for writing. These have been used across the school to support dialogue with the children on their strengths and next steps. Some staff have been out at 'Talk for Writing' courses to learn about different approaches to developing children's writing.

Staff had an INSET day on 13th February, where the focus was primarily on Numeracy and Mathematics. Some teaching staff have attended 'Number talks' courses after school and met with South Lanarkshire Council's Numeracy Support Officer. This helped support discussion on our approaches to mental maths and skills development.

We have been using our monitoring and tracking data for Literacy and Numeracy to ensure that we are targeting support in school.



As we have Ms Lennox and Mrs Ferguson out of class, they are working in partnership with teachers to support the teaching of writing in class and to provide additional writing and numeracy support.

Second Level Science

Numeracy and Maths

In literacy, we have been working on our story rhymes like 'ot' and 'at'. We have been changing endings to stories we know in our Fairy Land topic. We have looked at our number stories to 10 and started taking away in numeracy. We enjoyed making castles and a giant beanstalk as part of our Fairyland topic. We have been working on problem solving in class and dividing with bigger numbers. We have been writing stories in the way that Macastory showed us when they came in. We have been reading a story called 'The Thieves of Ostia' and we have made evidence boards in our groups. This term in literacy, we are focusing on inferring in our reading and writing information texts and instructions. We have been doing solo talks in class too. In numeracy and maths, we have been focusing on time, money, looking at all the different number operations and tackling word problems. In Health and Wellbeing we have been finding out about the sections of the 'Eatwell' plate and what different foods give us. We also did first aid with Mr Main to learn CPR. In maths we have been doing fractions, ordering them and learning about equivalent fractions. In literacy, we have looked at homophones, onomatopoeia, alliteration, and hyperboles. Our topic is 'the Big Band' and we have been split into groups or bands as we are touring Scotland. We have looked at the geography of Scotland and studied maps. We have also done lots of artwork like designing t-shirts, band posters and animal landscape pictures. Fraser and Mia, P7, R15 & 16

In literacy we have been looking at two letter sounds like sh, ch and th. We have been reading Fairyland stories and writing stories for Fairyland. In maths we have been working on taking away. In maths, we have been learning about addition to 1000 and we have been doing estimating, measuring and the volume of water. We have been working on numbers to 100, looking at odd and even numbers and having fun playing maths games. In literacy, we have been writing about the dinosaurs and creating dinosaur fact files. In literacy, we have been reading and following instructions and we will be writing instructions for others to follow. In maths, we have worked hard on fractions and we are now working on numbers up to 1000, including adding up to 100.
