
Woodie News - August 2024

Mrs Aitcheson and Mrs Lawson will be supporting children throughout the school. Miss McLarnon will be our Pupil Equity Lead and supporting children throughout the school.

Mrs Rice continues to lead our amazing Support Staff team. She will be joined in the office by Mrs Mitchell and Miss Shanahan.

Our Support staff team will provide targeted learning supports for children across the school. They will also support our children's wellbeing in the playground at break times, lunchtimes and throughout the school day. Supports will be delivered from :- Mrs Abercrombie, Mrs Brownlie, Miss Shanahan, Mrs Dalton, Mrs Muncie and Miss Grieve.

We continue to work in partnership with Place2Be. Our new Councillor is Megan Blaney (Mon and Tues) and our Youth, Family and Community Learning officer Evelyn McGonagle (Wed).

Nikki is our school Janitor and Lorraine is our School Cook.

Mrs McKellar provides pastoral care for all our Primary 1-3 children and manages their learning. Miss Officer provides pastoral care for all our Primary 4 -7children and manages their learning.





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Our School Improvement Plan

Every session we evaluate our current position and plan our improvement strategies for the year ahead. Our priorities this year are:-

- Enhance our curriculum by focussing on skills development,
 Sustainability and working towards the accreditation of our Silver Rights
 Respecting Schools Award.
- Introduce a 'Teach, Target, Play' approach in Primary 1 for maths and numeracy
- Develop a 'Learning, Teaching and Assessment' policy to ensure consistency across the school.
- Continue to reduce our Numeracy, Reading and Writing gap.
- Continue to focus on school attendance.
- Continue to work in partnership with Place2Be and Youth, Family and Community Learning Officer to provide supports for our targeted families and pupils.

For a quick and easy read I will send out a parental version of our School's Quality Improvement Plan next week via ParentsPortal. This highlights are key achievements from last session.

Miss McLarnon is leading our Equity Priorities. Each year the school is allocated money to be used to close our school equity gap. This year we have been allocated £121,275

5% of this budget, £6063.75 is called our Participatory Budget and is to be used in consultation with our children and parents. This means we are looking for your input and help.

Miss McLarnon will send out an email soon with more information.



School Gates

We have three main entrance gates into our school. These gates are managed by a member of our Support Staff Team every morning from **8.45am**. Please can I ask that you select the school gate which works best for your family and continue to use this the whole year, as our staff do a great job of getting to know the children and their families on their gate.

Toast to Go

Due to the size of our school we run a 'Toast To Go' service every day from **8.30am**. Children can only enter from the small gate at Johnstone Road where they then head round to our Dinner Hall for some toast, fruit and a drink before heading back out to play.

Gym Shoes

Can I ask that, if possible, you send in a pair of soft shoes which your child will change into every day for walking about in the building. We do have a supply of pre-loved shoes. If you require some just call the school office. Thank you.

Afterschool and Buses

If your child is attending an Afterschool Club or travels home on the school bus please can you send the class teacher a note to let them know which days this will be happening. If arrangements change, please inform the Office. At present, children who use our school buses will not be allocated a specified seat number. This may change as the session progresses.

Lost Property

Please make sure all clothing, water bottles and packed lunches are all clearly named. Lost property is cleared out at the end of each term.

Toys

We appreciate that some children bring small toys to school as a comfort. Can we kindly ask that these are kept safely in schools bags, in the classroom during learning time. Please speak to your child about keeping them safe in school as it can cause upset when they are lost or damaged.





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Please see the table below to find out which days your child will take part in physical education. Our PE lessons will take place both indoors and outdoors. This will be completely weather dependent!

On outdoor PE days your child can wear jogging trousers or leggings along with their school sweater. Please ensure they also wear a water-proof jacket, just in case. (A change of clothes may be an idea too!)



<u>On indoor PE days</u> your child will require to bring shorts and a T shirt to school to change into. Your child will wear their indoor shoes for PE lessons in the Gym Hall.

<u>Jewellery</u>—Sharp objects including items of jewellery should be removed wherever possible. Some items e.g. in newly pierced ears, may be covered over with tape. If you wish your child to continue wearing their earrings during PE lessons please can you provide a letter of consent for the class teacher.
