UNCRC Linked Rights

Article 11 (Protection from kidnapping)

The right to stay in your own country and not be taken out of it illegally.



Article 22 (Refugee Children)

The right to special protection of you have been forced to leave your home and live in another country.



Article 38 (Protection in War)

The right to be protected from war and not allowed to join the army if under 15 years of age.



Article 39 (Recovery and Reintegration)

The right to special support if you have experienced
